Flexible Delivery – Certificate IV in Food Science and Technology

RMIT in consultation with Industry is planning to convert the existing RMIT Certificate IV in Food Science and Technology course into a 2 year part time program which is delivered directly into the workplace by flexible delivery (e-learning and print based) and assessed via workplace based projects. Standard TAFE fees of approx \$600/yr would apply.

Workplace based projects and Problem based learning.

Course delivery uses workplace based project analysis to help develop students' problem-solving skills within a real workplace.

Benefits to Employers



- Improved workplace productivity and worker retention
- Professional development of workforce skills and knowledge of food science and food technology
- Up-skill and/or re-skill existing employees for higher level roles e.g. leading hands, food production supervisors, quality assurance officer, technical officer
- Minimum Downtime - employees study at home/work – only needing to attend RMIT University a maximum of 10 days / year over a 2 year period
- Potential to access government funded training places, new entrants may qualify as trainees with government subsidies.
- Potential to customise content and assessment to enterprise specific needs

Benefits to Employees

- Study while still working full time, only attending RMIT 2 x 5 day block release per year
- Improve your career opportunities, this program may assist in promotion to leading hand, supervisor, technical officer and other similar positions
- Complete an industry recognised qualification
- Obtain an RMIT University Certificate
- Have existing skills and knowledge formally recognised by recognition of prior learning through RMIT. (i.e. get credit for subjects you already know)
- Pathway to RMIT Diploma and Degree programs
